D6.1 Network website

The network website https://www.complete-h2020network.eu/ has been open to the public on July 12, 2017.

The website is divided into seven sections, two of which are also subdivided into more subsections: News, Team, Research Project (Abstract, Work packages, Milestones, Deliverables, Early Stage Researchers, Publications), Training, Dissemination (Conferences, Events, Press review, Social platform), Wiki, Contacts.

The section 'team' provides an overview of all the beneficiaries and partners and the ESRs hosted by the beneficiary partners. Descriptions of supervisors provide general information on their work and projects they are involved with. ESRs have their individual profile, their CVs and also comments where they can introduce themselves.

In the course of the project, the ESRs publications related to their work will also be published.

One of the categories, Wiki, is a special section which is usually not introduced in research projects websites. It is a collaborative space for students, supervisors, collaborators, administration, and network boards. It is accessible to all the ESRs and supervisors. There, ESRs and supervisors can introduce all the materials they are developing in COMPLETE (data, images, report, pre-print of manuscripts, presentations, graphs, experimental movies, various kinds of videos also for the outreach). The Wikispace can also be used as a repository for experimental data (laboratory, infield experimentation, numerical simulation). It is a place which allows a strong interaction among ESRs where they can create forums to exchange ideas or to discuss important issues or doubts. In Wikispace, ESRs and supervisors will be able to find local course materials including study aids, videos and on-line tutorials.
